In grade X board exam, total number of students were 29, out of them 28 students were qualified successfully. Total QPI / School average was 73.93% in first 5 subjects.

In Class X, 82.75% of our students secured 1st division marks, with 4 students obtaining 90% and above in the aggregate.

Our high achievers in SSE 2023 were Sankha Subhra Dutta, who excelled with a perfect 100 in English, Soumyadeep Jana achieved 99 in Bengali, Joheb Aman Mondal achieved 96 marks in Mathematics and 98 marks in Science and 99 in Social Science and so on.

b) Our Second topper was Soumyadeep Jana with 96.6%.
